### ***WHO WE ARE?***

The BUKAL Life Care and Counseling Center Inc., in Baguio City is a non-profit, ecumenical organization offering professional pastoral care & counseling as well educational trainings to individuals, couples, families and organizations in a faith context.

“Professional counseling and consultation” has to do with our strict adherence with the Philippine Republic Act 9258 on the professionalization of the guidance and counseling profession and with our professional, highly qualified, locally (Professional Regulatory Commission) and internationally (College of Pastoral Supervision and Psychotherapy) licensed and certified staff.

“Faith context” has to do with our awareness of spiritual issues and the way that the faith of our clients is a potential resource for healing.

### **Our Vision**

To assist individual and community transformation and healing through medical care, counseling, training, and community development in the Philippines.

### **Our Mission**

To provide healing, wholeness, and hope through counseling services, and education in pastoral care.

### ***OUR MINISTRIES***

#### **Pastoral Care & Counseling Center**

- Providing individual and family pastoral care and counseling.
- Psychological testing.

#### **Trainings in Lay Pastoral Care and Counseling**

The purpose of the lay pastoral care and counseling training program is to provide both structured practicum for clergies and interested lay persons to learn the theory and practice of counseling, various teaching and supervision opportunities to sharpen their skills in pastoral care and counseling. Training includes:

#### **Pastoral Care & Counseling Seminars.**

**Disaster Response Chaplaincy.** Training in crisis counseling, particularly within the context of disaster response. This is normally approximately 35-40 hours of class time.

**Shepherd in Every Pew.** 1-2 day training for laity in the church in the basic skills of pastoral care.

### **The Institute for Professional Chaplaincy- Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE)**

A ten-week program which consists of a minimum of 400 hours of supervised ministry and training. The CPE intern will spend eight hours per week in group learning, and 20-30 hours per week in the church/hospital providing pastoral care and counseling to patients, their families and staff. Each student will have 10 hours of individual supervision during the course. The weekday group time will include: clinical presentations by students, topic seminars, and a group process seminar each week. The number of students accepted into this program is limited, so please apply as soon as possible. Students will receive one unit of CPE credit. Our course work can be credited by a seminary.

Our CPE adopts the standards and is accredited by the College of Pastoral Supervision and Psychotherapy (CPSP) of New York, USA.
