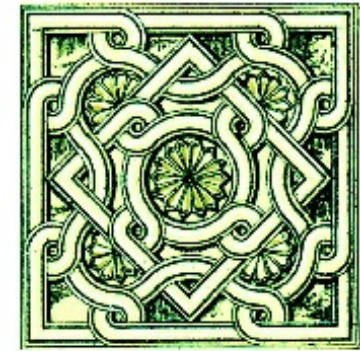

Chaplaincy Program

Our Clinical Pastoral Education (CPE) program is accredited by and adopts the standards of the College of Pastoral Supervision and Psychotherapy, or CPSP, based in New York (USA).

Our CPE supervisors are:

Dr. Raymond Lawrence has been a minister for 50 years. He presently serves as the General Secretary of the CPSP.

Rev. Joel S. Aguirre is the resident CPE Teaching supervisor. He was trained with the Association of Clinical Pastoral Education (ACPE) in USA and a board certified professional clinical chaplain and a CPE Supervisor with the CPSP. He is also a member to the Psychological Association of the Philippines (PAP).



Intensive Summer CPE Program

This 10-week program begins in March and continues through May. It consists of a minimum of 400 hours of supervised ministry and training. The CPE trainee will spend eight hours per week in group learning, and 20-30 hours per week in the church/hospital providing pastoral care and counseling to patients, their families, and staff. Completion of this program gives one unit of credit.



Extended CPE Program

This program is a continuation of CPE training for those students who wish to continue chaplaincy training, such as those who desire to be involved in CPE supervision. This program is held periodically throughout the year. Completion of the intensive program (unit 1) is a prerequisite.



We work with a number of hospitals and other social institutions to provide a broad range of opportunities for ministry and training. Additionally, we partner with certain theological seminaries, including Philippine Baptist (Baguio) and Saint Andrews (Marila) allowing the training to be transferred for the pursuit of advanced theological degrees.



The CPSP mission of CPE is to foster: "Experience-based theological education which combines the practice of pastoral care with qualified supervision and peer group reflection, and which is grounded in a person-centered approach to religious ministry."
